Between five and ten different diagnostic and therapeutic ERCP and EUS cases will be selected for demonstration. Attempts will be made to obtain representative cases from these categories: difficult bile duct stones and strictures, minor papilla stenting, sphincter of Oddi manometry, and altered anatomy (Billroth II gastrectomy and Roux-en-Y choledochojejunostomy), pancreatic masses and cystic lesions.

The Yale Interventional Endoscopy Team will perform the procedures with the audience viewing real time images. Dr. Patrick I. Okolo and Dr. Vanessa M. Shami will assist with the procedures as well as provide commentary and interact actively with the course participants. There will be ample opportunity for questions and discussions during and in between procedures.
